Dan will also be available on Tuesday to show individuals step-by-step processes to use the websites and newspaper archives.

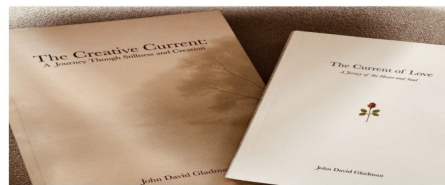
